Why did a phone network shut down in Spain?

A nationwide phone network has shut down in Spain just weeks after blackouts brought chaos and heavy financial damage to the country. Emergency services in a number of regions had to provide new telephone numbers for those in need, after phone lines collapsed following network upgrades by Telefonica.

What happened to Spanish telcos?

Spanish telcos have reported severe network issues caused by the nationwide grid outage. Both Spain and Portugal have been hit by widespread power outages today, bringing several major cities to a standstill. The outages have forced the Spanish rail network to shut down. Valencia and Barcelona were rendered completely without power.

Why did the power grid collapse in Spain & Portugal?

The limited penetration of battery backup solutions in the mobile site grids across Spain and Portugal was a key contributor to the scale of network disruption caused by the collapse of the power grid on April 28, providing a historic lesson on the importance of infrastructure redundancy.

What caused the Spanish rail network to shut down?

The outages have forced the Spanish rail network to shut down. Valencia and Barcelona were rendered completely without power. It's unknown what has caused the nationwide outage, but the impact has also been felt by telecom carriers in Spain, with 5G, Internet, and data services also affected.
