Do solar inverters come with a warranty?

String inverters typically come with 10-12 years of warranty coverage, whereas microinverters and power optimizers are often covered for 25 years. Labor and shipping expenses are generally not included in solar inverter warranties, but some of the strongest brands will cover one or both of these costs.

How long does a solar inverter last?

While the warranty terms for inverters themselves vary, warranties for communications equipment (which allow the inverter to connect to other devices like solar panels and battery systems) are typically capped at 5 years for both string inverters and microinverters.

How long is a power inverter warranty?

Usually, inverter manufacturers offer a standard warranty period of 10 years for string inverters, whereas module-level power electronics (MLPEs) like microinverters or power optimizers offer 25-year warranties. In the case of an extended warranty period, few manufacturers allow you to purchase extra warranty time for their products.

Which Inverter should I buy?

However, the best inverter for you largely depends on your system's unique needs: A 25-year microinverter warranty may rank higher than a 12-year string inverter warranty, but the string inverter may be better suited for your system and, therefore, more valuable to your investment.
