

Learn what Base Station Blinking Red indicates, including network problems, power faults, and easy fixes to restore proper function.

Wrong base station identification codes indicate either an error in base station settings, faulty base station equipment, or an issue with overlapping coverage from adjacent cells.

The app error "Device Connection Problem" occurs whenever the SimpliSafe® Mobile App cannot reach your Base Station. This can happen if the Base Station is not connected to its Wi-Fi or cellular ...

When troubleshooting Base Station alerts, you can remotely connect to the Base Station via SSH through the Show Terminal option in the Network Command Suite (NCS) software. This allows you ...

If your Base Station isn't connecting to Wi-Fi, troubleshooting would depend on the error message you're getting. Let's explore them individually and see how you can fix the issue.

A "No wifi networks found" message appears when your Ring Alarm Base Station cannot find an available wireless network to join. Without a connection, your Ring Alarm can't complete setup.
