

Unless you touch the panel battery glass. The only thing you need to touch is to clean the solar panels. Rinse the surface first and let it cool down. Wait for the temperature to drop slightly before cleaning ...

Solar panels are safe to the touch because the cells are covered by an aluminum frame and tempered glass. The cells under the glass generate current, but you can't touch them unless you break the glass.

Nothing will happen to you, but if you touch a damaged solar panel or wiring, it could give you a shock. So, don't touch the solar panel if it's broken or damaged somewhere.

Yes, you can touch solar panels as long as the system is installed correctly and the components are functioning properly. There is no risk of getting burned, even if the solar panel gets hot.

Yes, and you shouldn't be electrocuted. All these appliance are UL listed, just like a solar panel is. Walking on a solar panel is physically possible. You may create micro-cracks of your solar ...

Yes, you've got to complete the circuit to get shocked. But that's harder to do if you don't touch any portion of the conductor. Maybe make your MC4 crimps when not connected to the panels ...
