

DC Budget Scheme for Photovoltaic Battery Cabinets in Schools

No school will lose more than five percent of their submitted budget, inclusive of one-time local funds, from one year to the next. This safety net is in place regardless of shifts in enrollment.

Updated in FY23, DCPS' school budget model seeks to equitably resource schools across the district using three factors: enrollment, targeted support, and year-over-year stability.

To protect that progress, 20% of the Mayor's FY26 Capital Budget is dedicated to DC Public Schools.
