

# How many watts of solar lights are installed in Ho Chi Minh Vietnam

Viet Nam News reports that 5,485 rooftop solar systems have been installed on buildings in Ho Chi Minh City this year, bringing the metropolis' total to over 11,000.

Vietnam in general and HCMC in particular are located in a region with the highest distribution of solar radiation in the world for most of the year, where solar radiation is relatively intense.

If 50% of households in Ho Chi Minh City--about 1.1 million homes--installed rooftop solar systems with storage, the annual electricity output could exceed 7.5 billion kWh.

Below is the average daily output per kW of Solar PV installed for each season, along with the ideal solar panel tilt angles calculated for various locations in Vietnam.

According to statistics from EVNHCMC, Ho Chi Minh City currently has 13,985 rooftop solar power systems that have signed power purchase agreements in accordance with regulations.
