

# Japan Northwest Energy Storage Battery Plant

What is Kinokawa energy storage plant?

Kinokawa Energy Storage Plant has 64 lithium-ion storage battery containers installed within its premises. With a rated output of 48MW and a rated capacity of 113MWh \*2, it has the largest scale \*3 out of all energy storage plants currently operating within Japan and is the first to begin operation in ORIX's energy storage plant business.

What is Renova-Himeji battery energy storage system?

The Renova-Himeji Battery Energy Storage System is a 15,000kW lithium-ion battery energy storage project located in Himeji, Hyogo, Japan. The rated storage capacity of the project is 48,000kWh. The electro-chemical battery storage project uses lithium-ion battery storage technology. The project will be commissioned in 2025.

What is Nishi-Sendai substation - Bess?

The Nishi-Sendai Substation - BESS is a 40,000kW lithium-ion battery energy storage project located in Sendai, Miyagi, Japan. The rated storage capacity of the project is 20,000kWh. The electro-chemical battery storage project uses lithium-ion battery storage technology.

Who will operate a KEPCO storage battery plant?

KEPCO Group company E-Flow LLC will take on the operation of the storage batteries, including transactions on the electricity market, while ORIX Renewable Energy Management Corporation \*5 will be in charge of the plant's operation and maintenance (O&M) work.
