What is the upgrade of Ljubljana railway station - phase a?

The upgrade of the Ljubljana railway station - phase A - the construction of a replacement railway overpass across Dunajska cesta will include: replacing and expanding the structure of the existing railway overpass.

Will 5G Corridor infrastructure be co-funded in 2024?

Following the first set of projects launched in 2023, a second series of projects have been selected to co-fund 5G corridor infrastructure in 2024. Twelve projects, both works and studies, funded under the Connecting Europe Facility Programme - Digital (CEF Digital), were launched in the beginning of 2023 and are currently ongoing.

What is the 5g-adria project?

The 5G-ADRIA project will focus on defining what 5G infrastructure is needed to support future traffic-related services that will be used along TEN-T transport corridors in Slovenia and Croatia. Additionally, the proposed corridor is connecting core TEN-T ports in the northern Adriatic region, namely in Koper and Rijeka.

How much did the EU contribute to the 5G project?

Total EU Contribution: EUR 3 364 403 This project aims at deploying 5G and C-v2x infrastructure connecting cross-border road corridor sections along the Baltic-Adriatic 5G Corridor between Poland and The Czech Republic to enable high quality seamless network coverage and handover.
