

I just recently started playing omnifactory and i need to convert RF (From the Steam Dynamo in Thermal Expansion) to GTEU using the CEF (LV) but neither the Ender IO nor the Gregtech ...

I'm using Thermoelectric Generator all the time. Just place them with lava and water on both face and go !

I would think it would be Extreme reactors, but the best design i've come up with is a little over 2 million rf/t only. Placing solar panels would take forever too.

It produces up to 80 RF per tick depending on the time of the day when exposed to sunlight. It averages around 40 RF/ tick in the Overworld and a constant 40 RF/t in The End. The internal energy buffer is ...

The Solar Generator is a power generator block added by the Mekanism mod. It uses solar energy to generate power of up to 50 J/t (20 RF/t). It can store up to 96 kJ (38.4 kRF), with a maximal output of ...

This mod currently incudes a solar panel and a thermal generator. Both of these blocks have custom models. These generators make RF aka Forge Energy and i have tested them with thermal ...

The most I've ever seen was actually in the Sky Odyssey modpack, which uses Modular Machinery to build a custom generator that generates so much power that the only way to keep up is to put a ...

Due to the magical properties of redstone, RF ignores the real-world law of conservation of energy and is not necessarily entropic. Therefore, energy may be created from nothing, transported and stored ...

To generate RF, take an ender tank that has the same colour code as the one at the pump, and plop it somewhere you want to generate RF with the orange part of the dial pointed up. ...
