Are solar panels a scam?

Here's how to steer clear of the scams: Do some research. Avoid solar companies that say a government program will cover the whole cost of solar panels -- or say they're from (or affiliated with) the government. These are lies. If you're looking at solar energy for your home, get quotes from reputable providers with a valid license.

How do I avoid solar scams?

Here are some of our recommendations for avoiding solar scams: The saying "there's no such thing as a free lunch" applies when shopping for solar! If you see ads on social media or have a door-to-door salesperson stop by your home and share special programs that pay you to go solar, they're likely not legitimate.

Where can a consumer complain about a solar company?

"There's not really one place for consumers to complain to," says Jenifer Bosco, an attorney with the National Consumer Law Center. "If they do have a problem with solar companies, they can complain to the Federal Trade Commission. They might complain to the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau, they might complain to their state AG's office."

Is going solar free?

While there are some government-funded solar programs for households that qualify, "going solar" isn't free. Honest businesses will tell you exactly how much it'll cost to get and install solar panels. Here's how to steer clear of the scams.
