

Ukraine shuts down inverter connection to telecommunication base stations

Losses would be greater if Ukraine's forces didn't shoot down so many missiles. Western countries have promised to send more and better antimissile systems, spurred by the grid attacks.

Ukraine auctioned 5G spectrum in November 2024, raising UAH2.8 billion and requiring operators to build 1,500 new base stations in two years.
